ZONE TEAM COMPOSITION

The maximum team size shall be:

 $\underline{4}$ competitors per zone (# of females $\underline{2}$ # of males $\underline{2}$)

2 coaches or chaperones per zone (# of females $\underline{1}$ # of males $\underline{1}$)

FILL POLICY

- 1. The first opportunity to fill is provided to the host zone.
- 2. The second opportunity to fill is provided to the zone next to the Host with the greatest participation at the selection camp.

Fills must be submitted for approval to the Alberta Sport Connection by June 14, 2016.

ELIGIBILITY

Athletes

16U-born in 2000 or later

Athletes must tryout in the Zone where they reside

Coaches

Each Zone will have a minimum of one (1) member per zone registered as a coach that is National Coaching Certification Program Certified - Level 1 Volleyball .

Zones without a fully certified coach (or partially certified coach) should still make every attempt to send a coach who is interested in obtaining their full Level 1 Volleyball certification, and have an interest in learning more about Beach Volleyball coaching. Please contact the Provincial Sport Coordinator for more information.

All coaches and chaperones must be at least eighteen (18) years old by the start of the Alberta Games.

AFFILIATION

PROVINCIAL GAMES REGISTRATION FEE AND DEADLINE

All zone team competitors, who qualify to compete at the 2014 Alberta Summer Games (except coaches and chaperones), are required to pay an individual registration fee of **\$60.00**. This fee will offset costs related to transportation, accommodation, meals, zone identification, medals, athlete entertainment and sport competitions. This fee must accompany the athlete's registration form for the Provincial Games.

Please note that the registration deadline for Volleyball - Beach is **June 14, 2016**
