

New Arena Safety and Security Procedures

February 1, 2013

- All dressing rooms will now be locked prior to the arrival of all groups. Please contact our Arena Staff to sign out a dressing room key for your assigned room. While you are on the ice please lock your dressing room. After your ice time is done and your group has exited the dressing room please lock your room and return the key to the Arena Attendant.

- Before the ice resurfacer begins to complete a flood, coaches and instructors are asked to remove all items from the top of the rink boards and have all players exit the players' boxes. Players and coaches are not to enter the players' boxes until the ice resurfacer gates are closed.* This new requirement will ensure floods are completed in a safe timely manner eliminating incidents of arms and sticks coming in contact with the ice resurfacer, pucks being thrown on the ice, and items falling off the top of boards into path of the ice resurfacer. Failure to comply with this procedure will result in further investigation and possible corrective action.

We ask for your understanding as we work to improve the safety and security in our facilities.
