CONSTITUTION

ALDERGROVE MINOR BASEBALL ASSOCIATION

1. The name of the Society is **Aldergrove Minor Baseball Association** (the "Society").
2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - (a) To foster, improve and govern the game of baseball for youth in Langley and Aldergrove, in the Province of British Columbia, in accordance with the Official Rules of Baseball of Baseball Canada and the Rules and Bylaws of the British Columbia Minor Baseball Association;
 - (b) To instill in the participants good sportsmanship, honesty, team spirit, loyalty, and perseverance.
3. The charitable activities of the Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain for the members and any profits or other accretion to the Society shall be used as and when determined by the directors of the Society, in promoting the purposes of the Society. This Article 3 shall be unalterable.
4. The directors shall serve without remuneration, and the directors shall not receive, directly or indirectly, any profits from their positions as directors but may be paid reasonable expenses incurred by them in the performance of their duties. This Article 4 shall be unalterable.
5. Upon the dissolution of the Society, the assets of the Society remaining after the satisfaction of its liabilities and the proposed dissolution costs would either become the property of the British Columbia Minor Baseball Association to be held in trust until such time as a new baseball association in the Aldergrove and /or Langley area is formed or to an already established baseball association in the Lower Mainland of British Columbia area, whose objects would be compatible with those of the defunct Society. This provision is unalterable.
