Edmonton (EMSA) Community League

EMSA Community Programs are **competitive**. The EMSA Community league offers a higher standard of competition.

EMSA re-pools all teams three times during the season to ensure that competing teams are of a similar skill level.

The third round of games also includes the ability for all teams to compete for a place in the Edmonton City Finals around the end of February in whatever tier the team happens to end up playing in.

- Game day - Saturday, one practice a week.
- A 50 minute game (2 x 25 minute halves).
- Games will be played at one of the three Edmonton Indoor Soccer Centers.
- Play three (3) rounds of five (5) games with re-pooling at the end of the first and second rounds. (Pooling is based on team game results in the prior round).
- Games will be played in the Edmonton soccer centers.

FOCUS ON FUN, PLAYER SKILL DEVELOPMENT, AND TEAM PLAY

At this stage, players should participate in stimulating practices and games that develop technical skills in a fun atmosphere. The main emphasis should be on developing the primary soccer skills. Primary soccer skills are: proper form for shooting and passing, dribbling (using both left and right foot), team positioning and team play. The environment will be positive and the emphasis on fun and development. In U12 we want to move beyond individual play and move towards team play, so a focus needs to be placed on team positioning.
