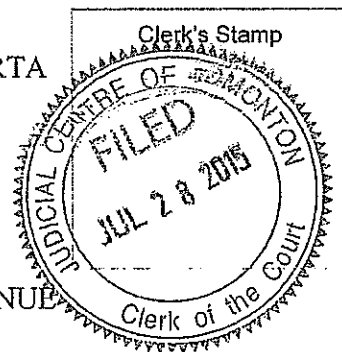



UPON THE APPLICATION of the Applicant; AND UPON READING the Affidavit of James Robert Ames, filed, and the pleadings filed herein; AND UPON HEARING the submissions of counsel for the Applicant herein:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The designation of Class "A" shares of the Applicant as voting shares is confirmed.
2. The publication of Notice of Special Meeting of Shareholders in the form attached to this Order as Schedule "A" (the "Notice") in the Calgary Herald, Edmonton Journal and Victoria Colonist on April 29, 2015 and the mailing of the Notice to each shareholder to his or her last known address on the Applicant's shareholders register in late April 2015 is hereby deemed to be valid service of this Originating Application on each shareholder.

3. The Court sanctions the amendment of the Applicant's shareholders register (the "Arrangement") as described in the form of special resolution attached to this Order as Schedule "B" (the "Special Resolution") and approves the Special Resolution for filing with the Registrar of Corporations.
4. The Applicant shall post the Order on the Applicant's website at <http://www.avonaircurlingclub.ca/> (the "Website") for a period of twelve months commencing as soon as practicable following the date of the Order. The posting of the Order on the Website shall be deemed valid service of the Order on each shareholder and service in this manner shall be deemed effected with respect to each shareholder upon the expiry of the twelve-month period. *A copy of this Order will also be posted at the Applicant's premises.*
5. Upon 30 days' notice to the Applicant, in care of Kirwin LLP, any affected Respondent may apply to vary the terms of this Order.
