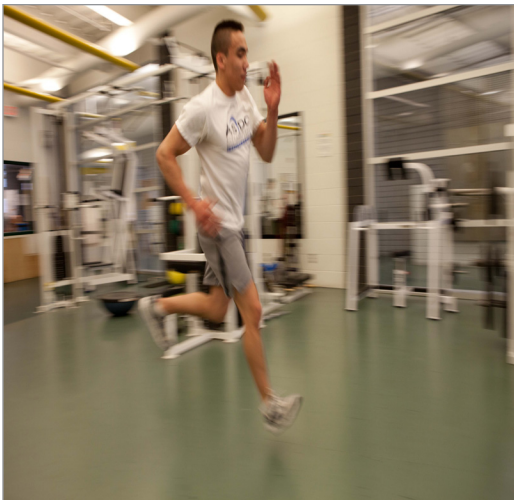

Concussion in sport was one of the top 10 news topics for 2011 - with much media attention focussed on professional hockey players such as Sidney Crosby. However, this significant injury is also commonly seen at all levels of recreational and competitive sports. For the young athlete in particular, there can be significant repercussions if the diagnosis is missed. There have been a number of recent advances in our understanding of concussion, and this presentation will focus on diagnosis and management, with recommendations for athletes, parents and coaches on safe return-to-play.
