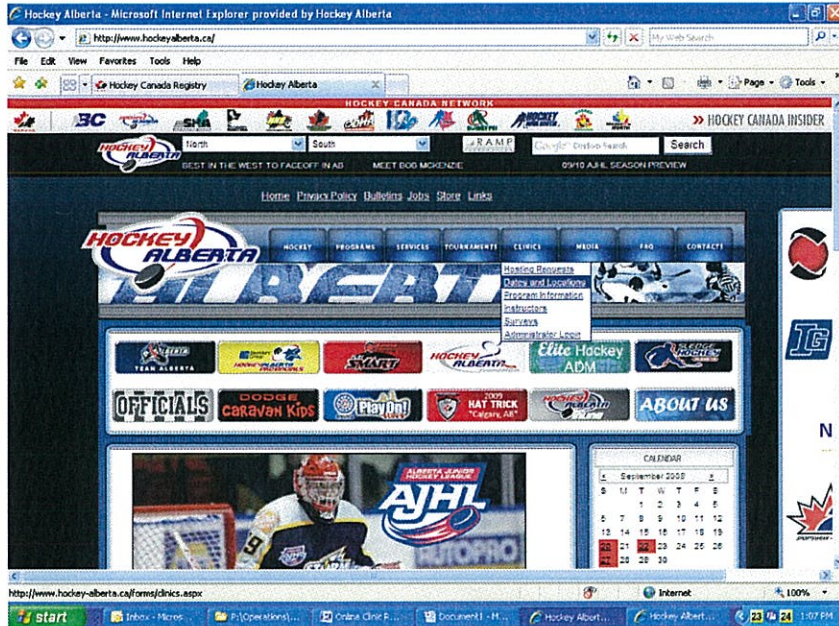
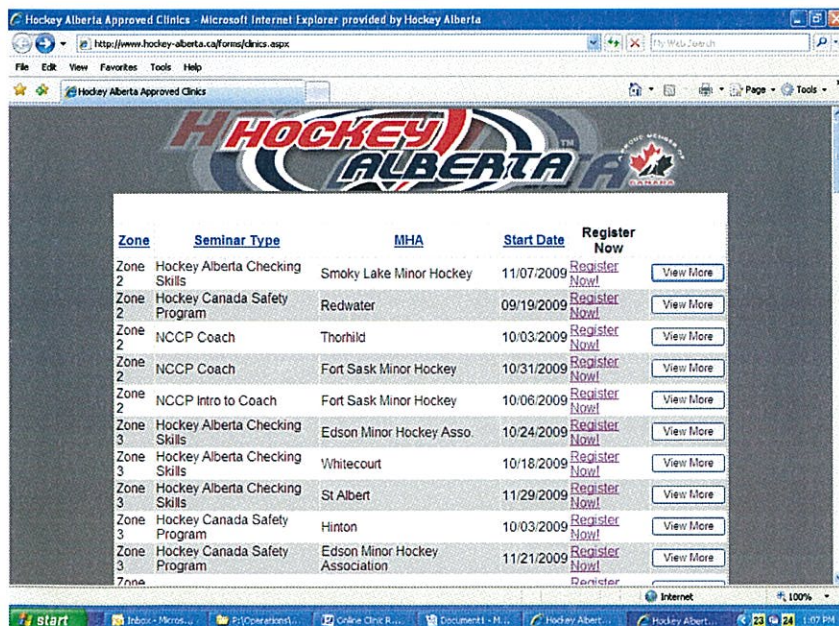


## Online Clinic Registration How to create an e-learning account

1. Find the clinic you are interested in taking on the Hockey Alberta website under the Clinics Tab – Dates and Locations

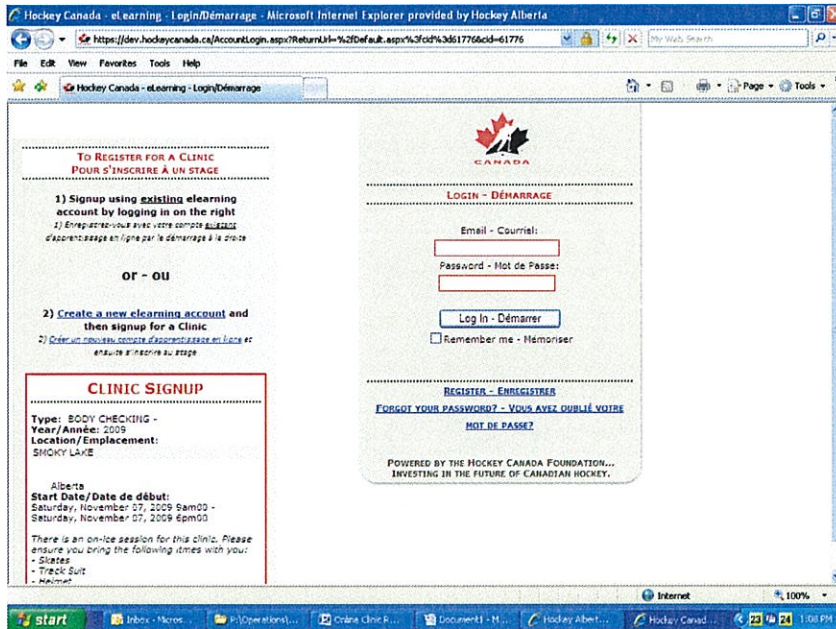


2. Once you have found the clinic you are interested in taking click on the “Register Now” link.

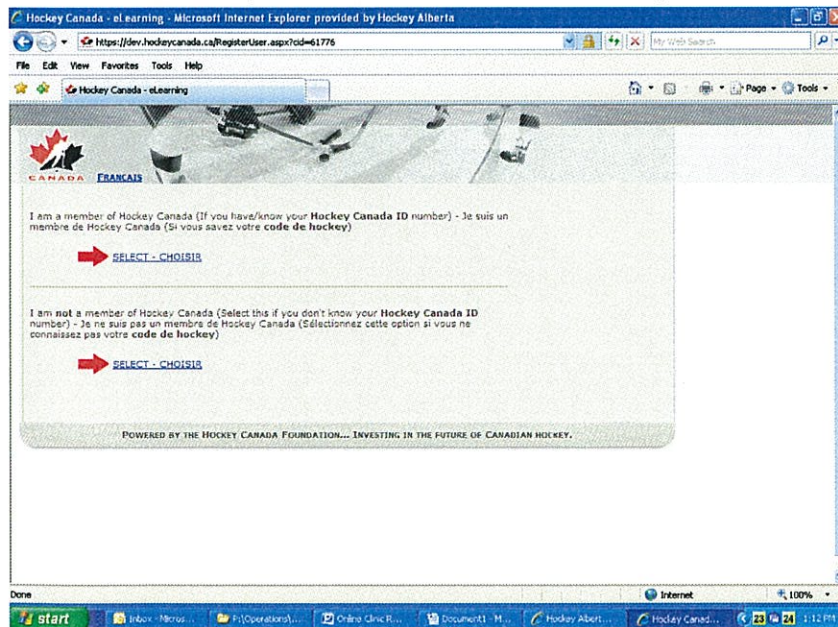


**\*\* Make sure you have got your HCR number from your Minor Hockey Association.**

3. To create an e-learning account select create an e-learning account from the left side of the screen.




4. Select the first option "I am a member of Hockey Canada...."
