Evaluations

- The player selection policy voted on and accepted at the last meeting, has been revised and distributed to members. If no further revisions are needed, it can be posted on the website.
- The dates and times for the evaluations has been set and posted on the website.
- The selection criteria for evaluations have been finalized and the skills drills for sessions 1 and 2 are almost complete. All association members will be privy to this info on the evaluation days.
- Myself and Chris Dussault will be the off-ice co-ordinators for the sessions. I am co-ordinating the preliminary details and Chris will oversee the evaluators, database recorders and on ice instructors during the 4 sessions. If he is not available during a session, I will fill in for him.
- Cory Fifield has agreed to assign jerseys to the players as well as distribute and collect jerseys during each session. Before he can do this, I have to divide the players into groups of green and whites. The groups have to be equal number of players and have an even distribution of the more skilled and less skilled players. I am attending the conditioning camp skates for both levels to get a good look at all the players before I send the groups to Cory Fifield. If for some reason he can't make a particular session, he is responsible to find a replacement.
- Chris Dussault and Clint Aarsby have agreed to find at least 4 evaluators per age group. I have not been informed of any evaluators committed to date.
- Cory Shields, with the assistance of Jeramie Heistad, has agreed to find on ice instructors to run the skills sessions. We will need one experienced lead instructor and 3 or 4 helpers per session.
- We will need 2 recorders to enter scores into the evaluation spreadsheet and perform calculations. One to enter scores and the other to double check entries. I think recorders do not have to attend the sessions? They are number crunching mathy types who like to keep secrets (Tyke Parents preferred). If there are tyke board members who would like to do this or know of some who is available, please let me know. Chris Dussault and I will oversee this process.

Other

- The girls dressing room has not been renovated as per the verbal agreement of our past president and the town of Didsbury.
- We need to decide on the number of teams at each level based on registration numbers and the amount of ice available for practices and games.
- We need to replace our pylons with more practical ones. The ones we have are great for construction sites only.
