

DRUMHELLER MINOR HOCKEY

PLAYER EVALUATION COMMITTEE

Goals and Objectives

1. To make sure that each player being evaluated is placed where he/she has the best opportunity to grow and develop at the level that best suits their overall hockey ability.
2. To ensure that every minor hockey member receives an evaluation package that explains to them how the process works, and what the evaluators will be looking for. (Reference: Hockey Canada Guidelines)
3. To organize the ice sessions for each seasons evaluations.
4. To build a scoring rubric for the evaluators to use during evaluation sessions. Including a reference sheet explaining each category on the rubric.
5. To evaluate players who for unforeseen circumstances cannot take part in the evaluation sessions. (Doctors notes will be needed if the reason is injury or illness) Evaluations must take place before January 1st. Any new player or injured player has an equal opportunity to make the top tiered team.
6. To find Evaluators with hockey knowledge and evaluation experience, if at all possible. Use goalie Evaluators for Atom and above levels.
7. To develop and revise as necessary the player evaluation policies for approval by the Board of the Drumheller Minor Hockey Association.
8. To use tier numbers and/or team names instead of "A" and "C" Teams.
9. To be available and have questions and/or concerns about evaluations directed to the Player Evaluation Committee Chair Person.
10. To support all members of the DMHA by promoting communication regarding player evaluations.
