

REGISTRATION AND FEE POLICY Objective:

To ensure all players are registered for insurance purposes and that fees and volunteer hours are appropriate to meet the goals of the Drumheller Minor Hockey Association (DMHA).

Policy Statement:

All players must be registered with and fees paid to DMHA before being permitted to tryout, practice, or play in a game.

POLICY GUIDELINES Registration:

Hockey Alberta designates age as the criteria for registration based on age at December 31st in the registration year.

Categories as follows:

- Midget 15, 16 & 17 years old
- Bantam 13 & 14 years old
- Pee Wee 11 & 12 years old
 - Atom 9 & 10 years old
 - Novice 7 & 8 years old
 - Tykes 4, 5 & 6 years old

Fee Structure for 2013/2014 Season

Tyke: Mondays \$150.00 Tyke: Thursday \$200.00
Monday & Thursday - \$300
Novice - \$345 • Atom - \$375 • Pee Wee - \$430
Bantam - \$465 • Midget - \$520

Fees may be paid as follows:

- A) Paid in full at time of registration
- B) 1st cheque (50%) - dated Sept. 4th, 2013
- C) 2nd cheque for remainder - dated Dec. 15, 2013

A separate cheque must be issued for the volunteer fee and can be paid in full or separate post-dated cheques dated to January 15, 2014.

Drumheller Minor Hockey requires funding beyond registration fees, in order to maintain a reasonable fee structure for all participants.

It is mandatory for parent or guardians of players registered with DMHA to contribute twelve (12) hours of volunteer concession time for each player that they have registered. The family maximum will be twenty (20) hours.

A deposit **separate cheque** will be required in the amount of **\$200.00 for one child from Novice to Midget** or **\$250.00 for two or more players from Novice to Midget and \$100.00 for a tyke player**. Should the volunteer hours not be completed by January 30, deposit cheques will be cashed. After January 30 refunds will be issued for volunteer hours worked.

A parent/guardian who does not wish to participate in the mandatory volunteer fee is to advise the Registrar at time of registration. The volunteer fee will be paid at time of registration.

Concession hours will include casino, coaching, executive positions and any other functions that DMHA determines as necessary to achieve the fundraising objective. Signing up for concession volunteer hours is the responsibility of each family. There is a sign up calendar located at the concession. All volunteers for concession shifts shall be over the age of 18. The concession calendar shall be closed off 7 days prior to available shifts. Anyone who cancels a shift with less than three (3) days notice to the concession manager

shall be penalized 4 additional hours.
