## 2012-2013 Hockey Registration

June 11 & 18, 2012 7:00 – 9:00 PM at Bellevue Hall (7308 112 Ave.)

June 24, 2012 1:00 – 3:00 PM at Bellevue Hall (7308 112 Ave.)

Get a jump on your back-to school expenses, and register your child for hockey a little earlier this season. All Northstars children who register in June will be entered into our early-bird draw for the chance to win a free registration to our August Training Camp (one prize for our Novice/Atom group and one for our Peewee/Bantam camp).

Fees for the 2012-13 season have increased, but included in the registration fee will be 4 tickets to our annual Galaxyland event, to be held this season on Friday, October 12, 2012 (you'll be able to use these tickets yourself, sell them, or even give them away if you choose). Additionally, outside of each family's volunteer commitment at bingos *there will be no extra fundraising required by the clubs* (for the Northstars, this means you won't need to sell Grey Cup tickets and Braves families won't be selling water park tickets).

Additionally, Hockey Edmonton has recently mandated that all families involved with minor hockey must complete the online *Respect in Sport Program* prior to registering for the 2012-2013 season. You can access this course through the Hockey Edmonton website ([www.hockeyedmonton.ca](http://www.hockeyedmonton.ca)). At the conclusion of the class, you'll receive a confirmation code, which you will be required to provide at registration. *You will not be able to register your child for the hockey season if you have not completed this course.*

In addition to your Respect in Sport program code, don't forget to bring the enclosed, completed forms, a calendar for bingo dates, and cheques for bingo deposits. Payment options for registration fees include cash, cheque, and credit card.

## It's Time! Go On-Line to Complete the Respect in Sport Program

*"99% of parents are good people wanting to do the right thing"*

The Respect in Sport Program is an online course designed to reinforce the role of parents in a child's sports activities, reinforce positive behaviours in sport, and provide insight into the role coaches, referees and other officials play in the game.

The Edmonton Northstars will be following the directive of Hockey Edmonton and Hockey Alberta which requires each family to have a parent(s) complete the one hour on-line Respect in Sport Parent Program. *You will not be able to register your child if you have not completed the Respect in Sport Program.*

To complete the program, simply visit the Hockey Edmonton website ([www.hockeyedmonton.ca](http://www.hockeyedmonton.ca)) and click on the Respect in Sport Parent program. You will then be prompted to register on-line for the course. There is a fee (\$12 plus GST) to complete the course. Once you have completed the 60-minute on-line class, you will receive a confirmation code. You'll need to have this code in order to be able to register your child for hockey.

*Please remember that you must bring your Respect in Sport confirmation code in order to register your child for the 2012-13 hockey season.*
