



Registration Information for New Residents

Welcome to the City of Fort Saskatchewan!

We hope that your transition to your new community will be a smooth one, including registering your player for hockey. We are fortunate to have programs for just about everyone, come and check us out!

If you have a player to register that has never played before anywhere at anytime, you are free to go to www.fsmsa.net and follow the links to create an online account and register for the season, camps and/or tryouts. Please provide a copy of your child's birth certificate to the office, through our email at fmh@telus.net. As well, all hockey players in the province of Alberta are required to have one parent complete a Respect in Sport Course online. Please find more information about the program under the Information tab on our website.

If you have a player that has played elsewhere in another association at anytime, please contact Fort Saskatchewan Minor Hockey (Sports Coordinator) at fmh@telus.net or at 780-998-1835, then please follow the following instructions.

You will be required to submit to Fort Saskatchewan Minor Hockey:

1. A completed Hockey Alberta Parent Declaration Form
2. A photocopy of your player's Birth Certificate
3. Two different pieces of the four accepted proof of residency documents:
 - Driver's Licence
 - Utility Bill
 - Child's Registration in a Fort Saskatchewan School
 - Bill of Sale or Rental Agreement on a Fort Saskatchewan residency

Once received, Fort Saskatchewan Minor Hockey will initiate a request for transfer and you will be able to go to our online registration, create an account and register for the season, camps and or tryouts.

All players registered in Fort Saskatchewan Minor Hockey must have a parent that has taken the Respect in Sport-Parent Program Course. Proof of completion of the program must be listed to the players HCR profile, prior to participation in any program. The FSMH Sports Coordinator will have access to this information.
