Summary

Lighting – comments around lighting included; more light, better lighting, improved lighting, more light posts, lighting for safety, 1 person said “Typically used in summer when hours are long. I don’t think lighting is a significant concern” 1 person asked for lights at crosswalks to enter park.

Sand – the following is a break down of the comments around sand.

- 5 people said the sand needs to be cleaned more often due to garbage, cat waste, glass, needles, sharp items. A few of these responses also suggested replacing the sand with a rubber surface.
- 6 people requested that the sand be removed and replaced with rubber/recycled tires.
- 2 people asked for the sand to be removed and replaced with wood chips
- 1 person said less sand, more soft surface like Castledowns
- 1 person suggested no rocks
- 1 person asked for a Sandless Playground

Shade -

- There were 6 people who requested shade. Each response was a bit different
- Need more shade, either trees or shade structures,
- A shaded area to sit for parents or children to cool off,
- Shade by playground
- More shaded areas

Playground & Wooden Structures

- To remove/replace old wooden structures 3 comments
- replace with metal or plastic
- Wooden structures - kids get slivers and scratches, 3 comments
- more swings (not tire)
- Parts of the park cannot be played on as they are broken, broken equipment - 2 comments
- Better Playground maintenance

Basketball Courts - 4 comments

- Re-furbish the basketball court. Add chain nets to hoops. Paint backboards.
- The basketball hoop faces the busy roadway without a fence high enough to stop fly away balls
