- There will be more releases made to each Tier as the teams are finalized. These final releases will be performed with player, parent, coach, coordinator meetings
- Players not listed on any of these tiered lists are assigned to the recreation program. Please check the schedules for the house division coordination.
- Attached below is the Policy that FSJ will follow for the team selection process.
- If Parents request Meetings about these tryout results, they will be accepted after the ice breaker weekend.

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Policy 6.10 Player Selection for all Competitive Teams

- Players who wish to be considered for a Tier 3 (B) team must attend the Tier 2 (A) tryouts. Requests for exception from this rule must be made in writing to the executive and received prior to August 30.
- A Selection Committee will be formed for each Divisional/Team tryout. The Selection Committee will consist of the Competitive Directors, Coach Director, on-ice helpers and independent evaluators.
- The ratio of evaluators to players should not exceed 10:1
- The Hockey Canada guidelines for evaluation and placing Players on teams will be followed
- Players will be assessed while performing preset basic and advanced skills along.
- All team selection staff, on-ice helpers and evaluators must be approved by the Executive.
- Player attitude will also be a governing factor
- The tryout process will be communicated to the Players and Parents prior to the first ice time
- Each Player will have at least 3 ice times during the tryout process.
- The team coach will have the final say on the last 5 player selections.
- FSJMHA will use their website (fsjminorhockey.ca) for announcements of releases until after the evaluation process is complete.
- Individual release meetings will be coordinated with the player, parents, team coach and competitive directors for the final three releases.
- Players wishing to self-release must follow the Voluntary Player Releases
