## **NEW & TRANSFERRING PLAYERS:**

Registrations for new and transferring players will be accepted starting June 1st. Online registration is NOT available for new players to our association. This includes players registered with us in 2016-17 on a Residential Waiver transfer. A paper Registration Form will be available June 1<sup>st</sup>.

A birth certificate or passport is required when registering a new player.

Players moving into Kamloops from another association must also complete a Player Movement Application, along with the registration form and include the required documentation supporting residency.

Players from neighbouring associations wishing to play in Kamloops must first obtain a Residential Waiver form from their home association. The Residential Waiver must be signed by the association President and declare that they do not have an applicable team for the player to participate on.

KMHA made it mandatory starting in the 2013-14 season that all players have a parent/guardian take the Respect In Sport (Parent) course prior to participation. Once the course is completed it will appear on the players Hockey Canada registration profile. Until the course is completed any NEW Player(s) will not be able to participate.
