

Lincoln Minor Hockey 2011 BB / AE Tryout Information

- Tryouts are utilized to provide a fair and impartial assessment of a players total hockey skills.
- Tryouts ensure that all players have a reasonable opportunity of being selected to an appropriate team.
- Tryouts provide coaches with the opportunity and flexibility to build a team based in part on their own coaching philosophy and knowledge of player skills and attitude.
- Tryouts will be conducted by each team's respective coach.
- An Assistant Coach who has no affiliation with players and has been pre – approved by L.M.H.A. will be allowed to participate at tryouts.
- Coaches will provide evaluators with no affiliation to the team they are evaluating and have also been approved by L.M.H.A

Player Selection Criteria:

- Skating, Passing, Puck Control, Shooting.
- Positional Play, Checking Concept, Attitude.

Goalie Selection Process:

This season Goalies will be independently evaluated by current Brock Badger Goaltenders.

Goaltender Selection Criteria:

- Skating Skill - Position Specific Movement Skills - Position / Save Movement Skills - Rebound Control / Recovery / Tactical - Transitional Play - Advanced Positioning - Attitude

For all players, initial releases may be made after the 2nd tryout and will be done in person and individually. Any player released will be added to the A/E tryout roster. Novice and Atom aged players are to be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. All releases will be conducted by the Coach and an L.M.H.A. board member. Parents may request a separate meeting at a later date with coach and L.M.H.A. to discuss individual player's evaluation.

We realize that tryouts are a stressful time for parents and players. With this in mind L.M.H.A. are striving to make the tryouts as transparent and fair as possible.
