Reviewed Minutes of the Annual General Meeting

- A Motion to dispense with a reading of the Minutes from AGM 2012 was made by Nick Ruigrok and seconded by Amanda Germain. All in favor.
- Minutes were approved by Missy Munroe and seconded by Nick Ruigrok.

Reports

- President, Robert Mercier – Please see attached presentation; discussion based on presentation
 - New ice surface at Dunbow should be available by Fall/13. This will be managed by the MD. OMHA will be given 60% of prime time ice (weekdays – 4:30pm-9:30pm and weekends 8am-6pm).
- Administrative Assistant – Karen Arnholtz – Please see attached presentation.
 - Respect in Sport – Thanks to team managers for encouraging all members to complete this. Most members have completed the program.
- Operations Coordinator – Jamie Steer - Please see attached presentation.
 - In response to a question regarding 2 PeeWee AA teams, Jamie explained that the league will be enforcing this.
- VP, Programs – Jeff Faye - Please see attached presentation.
 - There were few issues surrounding evaluations. Directors did well getting teams organized. A sub-committee has been formed to look at the evaluation process.
 - The Emergency Action Plan will be put into place in Okotoks.
 - Nicole Pearse asked who will be on the Evaluation sub-committee. This sub-committee will begin as a board sub-committee, with the possibility of having other members join at a later date.
 - A question was asked regarding why we are not using outside evaluators for goalies. Jeff Bahr explained that we have Dean Stabler coordinate these evaluations. Outside evaluators do evaluate the goalies as well. But goalies are evaluated during their separate sessions. This will be looked at again by the sub-committee.
- VP, Coach and Player Development – Jeff Bahr - Please see attached presentation.
 - We are about one month into the new Coach Mentorship program. Feedback has been positive and coaches are accepting of the help. This will be evaluated at a later date.
 - Of 276 coaches in OMHA, only 31 have not been certified by RIS.
 - Police Checks must be completed every 3 years by volunteers. We may incorporate an online background check to be done every year.
 - It was asked if Coach Clinics could be done earlier. Hockey Alberta doesn't want the clinics done prior to Sept 1st in a given season. However, some clinics (Coach Development) are done in April.
 - A question was asked if we are checking to see if RIS is being applied by coaches. This will be apparent through Game and Conduct issues. The membership is responsible for bringing issue forward to the managers on their team.
- Treasurer – Bob McMaster - Please see attached presentation.
 - We will likely have a deficit of \$144,500, mainly due to the one-time cost of our jersey replacement, as well as increased ice costs. This will be covered by the OMHA reserve fund. Discussion was held. Mike Reiber made a motion to accept the Financial Statement as presented. Carolyn Mercier seconded. All in favor. Carried.
- Directors Reports were presented. Please see presentation. No discussion.

Treasurer's Report

Fiscal Year 2012/2013

- May 31 is year end, the OMHA's annual CA Prepared Financial Statements and 2012/2013 budget to be presented at IGM in Nov 2013
- 2012/2013 yearend was in line with budget
- OMHA purchased new jerseys as more than half of the old jerseys had to be replaced
- The OMHA will contribute more money towards the Dunbow facility in order to have it practice/game ready for mid-October (\$45/player)
- We have increased fees by 5% as we do need to re-establish the reserve fund
- Ice costs to increase by 5 to 6 % on YOY basis
- Cancellation fees:
 - after registration but before tune ups \$50/player
 - after the start of tune ups, \$50/player plus pro-rated ice time
 - after teams have been carded, \$75/player plus pro-rated ice time

Ice Report

- Initiation: This division had 9 teams. They practiced almost every Wednesday for an hour, shared with three teams on the ice. On Saturday they played with 4 teams being there for 1 ½ hours and 4 more for another 1 ½ hours. One team got a bye and usually they were worked around tournaments.
- Novice House Teams: This division had 11 teams, three being female. They practiced twice each week for an hour on half ice, same day and same time. On the weekend they had 5 game spots so 10 teams played and 1 had a bye week. Again the byes were worked around tournaments as best as the director could. They had 20 weeks of games so around 18 home games that were 1 hour and 15 minutes in length.

Ice Report

- Atom House Teams: This division had 6 teams. They practiced twice each week for an hour on half ice, same day and same time. On the weekend they had 3 game spots so all 6 teams would play if in town and if a team away a team may get 2 games. They had 20 weeks of games so around 20 home games that were 1 hour and 15 minutes in length.
- Novice and Atom travel: 2 Novice and 5 Atom travel teams and 1 female atom travel. They practiced twice each week for an hour on half ice, same day and same time. They played in the CAHL and RMFHL and had between 15 and 20 league games with half being at home plus play-offs. These games were 1.5 hours.

Ice Report

- **Peewee:** We had 7 male and 2 female teams. Each team practiced 2 times a week for an hour. They sometimes had a shared practice and they always had an alone if they practiced in the morning. They had many 30-30-30 and 45-15-45 practices as well. They also had some alones at night. The female teams had no mornings so they were shared and at same time. The boys played in the CAHL and the females in the RMFHL and both had around 16 to 20 games plus play-offs for the teams that made it, half at home. The games were 1.5 and 2 hour spots.
- **Bantam:** We had 5 males and 1 female Bantam team. The boys normally had an alone in the morning and an alone at night. The night time was sometimes a 30-30-30 but for the most part they were all alone. The female teams had no mornings so they had a few more shared or 30-30-30 at night. They all played in the CAHL/RMFHL and played in excess of 18 games including play-offs, half at home. The games were in 2 hour spots.

Ice Report

- Midget: We had 4 males and 2 female Midget teams. The boys had a morning and a night alone, always the same days. The females had a 30-30-30 Monday in Okotoks and normally an alone in Okotoks on Wednesday. This was done so they could all schedule around work. They all played in the CAHL and played 18 to 22 games including play-offs, half at home. The games were in 2 ½ or 2 hour spots.
- General
Additionally, we had 3 ice times on Wednesday in Stavelly. We used the outdoor rink in Black Diamond from November through February, 4 times a week, when the weather allowed. The Pee wee and Bantam boys and female Bantam and Midget girls rotated through Stavelly on Wednesday. The outdoor ice was given to every team once this season from Atom through Midget, female and male. A few teams had it up to 3 times.

OMHA Atom Season Overview

Okotoks Minor Hockey registered 180 Atom aged players (9 & 10 years old) making 11 teams. 5 teams played in the travel division (80 players) and 6 teams (100 players) made up the Atom house division. 30 players were selected for 2 parity travel teams to play in the CAHL Tier 2 level. Goaltending was a challenge for Atom this season with only 13 registered goaltenders after registration. Congratulations to our Atom tier 4 Oilers for winning the CAHL Atom tier 4 banner this season and the Atom Wildcats for winning the Atom House Cup!

Peewee 2 Green Head Coach Jeff Hill - Played in T2, lost out in 1st round against Lethbridge, placed 4th overall. Record of 7-6-5

Peewee 2 Gold Head Coach Jeff Bahr - Played in T2 as well, missed playoffs by 1.5 points, placed 5th overall. Record of 6-9-3

Peewee 4 Green Head Coach Bob Valleau - Played in T4, did not make playoffs, placed 9th overall. Record of 6-16-1

Peewee 4 Gold Head Coach Doug Paterson - Moved to T4, did not make playoffs, placed 11th overall. Record of 2-18-2

Novice - Had two full novice teams. Coached by Greg Gibbs and Nick Ruigrok. They played in the Novice B house league.

Atom - Travel team was coached by Barry Borbely. Undefeated in RMFHL regular season and playoffs. Lost in the semifinals of provincials after undefeated round robin. For the first year we had a second atom team, coached by Mark Poelzer. Played successfully in Novice A house league.

PeeWee - Had two small teams in RMFHL. The A team was coached by Colin Aitken and the B team was coached by Garry Poelzer. Both team struggled in their divisions. Would likely have been a better fit as one B team but there were too many players.

Bantam - Team was coached by Travis Theissen. Played RMFHL Tier 1 with 20 skaters and 1 goalie so player were scratched on a rotating basis. Won the Blue division of RMFHL. Finished 3rd in pool at provincials.

Midget - Played in RMFHL for the first time. Midget A was coached by Roddie Davidson. Ended up just under .500 for the year in league play. Midget B was coached by Stu Rowley. Was a much better year in RMFHL than the previous year in CAHL.
