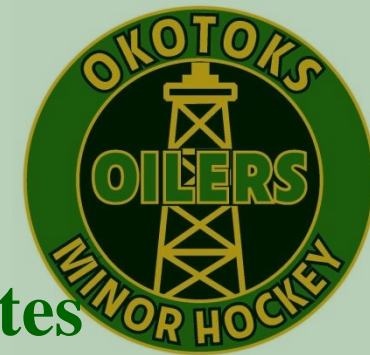

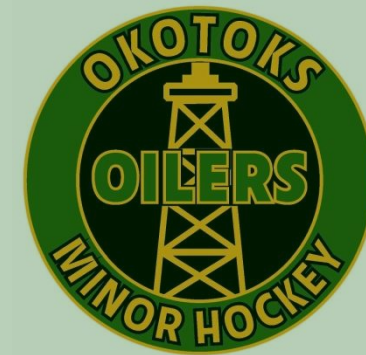

### Fiscal Year 2013/2014

### Tune-Ups and Clinics

- 13<sup>th</sup> year that OMHA provided Tune-ups
- Did not run a checking clinic this season with the change to body contact starting in Bantam but may start again next season.

### Ice Report

- **Initiation:** This division had 12 teams. They practiced Tuesday or Wednesday for an hour, shared with three teams on the ice. On Saturday morning they all played being mixed with 3 teams on ice an hour each or 4 teams being on 1 hour and 15 each
- **Novice House Teams:** This division had 10 teams, two being female. They practiced twice each week for an hour on half ice, same day and same time. On the weekend they played and averaged over 1 game a weekend. They had 20 weeks of games so around 22 or so home games that were 1 hour and 15 minutes in length.

## Operations Coordinator Report cont...

### Ice Report

- **Atom House Teams:** This division had 6 teams. They practiced twice each week for an hour on half ice, same day and same time. On the weekend they played and averaged over 1 game a weekend. They had 20 weeks of games so around 22 or so home games that were 1 hour and 15 minutes in length.
- **Novice and Atom travel:** 2 Novice and 6 Atom travel teams and 2 female atom travel. They practiced twice each week for an hour on half ice, same day and same time. They played in the CAHL and RMFHL and had between 15 and 20 league games with half being at home plus play-offs. These games were 1.5 hours.

## Operations Coordinator Report cont...

### Ice Report

- **Peewee:** We had 7 male and 3 female teams. Each team practiced 2 times a week for an hour. They sometimes had a shared practice and they always had an alone if they practiced in the morning. They had many 30-30-30 and 45-15-45 practices as well. They also had some alones at night. The female teams had no mornings so most were shared. The boys played in the CAHL and the females in the RMFHL and both had around 16 to 20 games plus play-offs for the teams that made it, half at home. The games were 1.5 and 2 hour spots.
- **Bantam:** We had 6 males and 2 female Bantam team. The boys normally had an alone in the morning and an alone at night. The night time was sometimes a 30-30-30 but for the most part they were all alone. The female teams had no mornings so they had a few more shared or 30-30-30 at night. They all played in the CAHL/RMFHL and played in excess of 18 games including play-offs, half at home. The games were in 1.5 or 2 hour spots.

### Ice Report

- **Midget:** We had 4 males and 2 female Midget teams. The boys had a morning and a night alone, always the same days. The females had a 30-30-30 Monday in Okotoks and normally an alone in Okotoks on Wednesday. This was done so they could all schedule around work. They all played in the CAHL and played 18 to 22 games including play-offs, half at home. The games were in 2 ½ or 2 hour spots.
- **Rec:** We had a Rec team that was called Midget Rec and had a practice Wednesday and played on Saturdays

### Initiation 2013/2014:

Sports participation can help children develop social skills that will benefit them throughout their entire lives. Overall the season was a great success and parents from other levels of hockey have made many inquiries for the possibility of their child's division joining the rec league. My suggestion would be to strictly maintain the integrity of the recreational league with guidelines set out regarding tournaments and games. The other cities that are involved in the rec league have and maintain a "grass-root" attitude that will be met with opposition if any team tries to put forth much change, ie: more tournaments, more games etc. It was a pleasure to be involved with the Rec league this year.
