

# CONDUCTING 50/50 DRAWS AT ROTARY PARK

50/50 draws are a great revenue source for PBSA. Draws are conducted when there are 3 or more games underway at Rotary Park. For schedule of 50/50 volunteer opportunities contact the PBSA Volunteer Coordinator at [volunteers@pbsa.ca](mailto:volunteers@pbsa.ca).

## Conducting a 50/50 Draw

- Supplies and detailed "how to" information for the 50/50 draw is in the clubhouse office. Keys to the office are in the concession or available through the Park Parent.
  
- Simply put:
  - Sell the tickets at all the games in the park. Children are allowed to "help", just ensure you are in charge of the money at all times. Note: We have a mix of start times, so just remember you have to draw a winning ticket before any game to which you are selling tickets ends.
  - Count up the money and divide it in half. Pay out the small change and smaller bills to the winner and keep the larger denominations for the park.
  - Draw the winning ticket and announce the number using the mike at the concession.
  - Record all the details required on the 50/50 ledger sheet, pay the winner, and have the winner sign the ledger sheet.
  - Put the winning ticket (both sides) and the profits in a marked envelope and hand it into the concession staff to put in the safe.
