- 1. Referee-in-Chief must be a carded official, or previously carded, to ensure proper training and supervision of PMHA officials.
- 2. Carding and insurance fees will be the responsibility of the Referee. A portion of such fees will be refunded based on the *participation threshold* having been reached.
- 3. The Referee-in-Chief is authorized to limit referee applications.
- 4. Only carded officials may be used by PMHA. Society membership fees are waved for CHA carded officials.
- 5. Referee-in-Chief to ensure that proper instruction, training and supervision are given to all officials.
- 6. Referee-in-Chief to conduct regular meetings and on-ice sessions for officials to enhance skills and knowledge.
- 7. Referee-in-Chief will organize monthly pay schedule for regular games and payment within two days after tournament play.
- 8. Referee-in-Chief may assign all or part of the games and may choose to have an assistant for scheduling.
- 9. Referee-in-Chief may deny assignment of on-ice or minor officials for cause.
- 10. All complaints against officials must be made in writing to the Membership Committee using an *incident report form* and should be subject to a 24-hour 'cooling off' period. Complaint will be processed based on rule interpretation and decorum only.
- 11. Abuse of officials by spectators will not be tolerated, as per OMAHA regulation 10,000. All complaints will be reviewed by the Membership Committee.
