



2016-2017 BIG ROCK MEN'S SUPER LEAGUE

QUALIFICATION INFORMATION

The 2016-2017 Big Rock Men's Super League will include a maximum of 12 Teams.

1. As many as 8 Teams will pre-qualify through a Cumulative Points System. This system recognizes individual performance in Major Championships (Brier, Canada Cup, Players, and Worlds), in Selected Other Championships (Provincials, Senior Provincials & Nationals, Junior Provincials & Nationals, Juvenile International and University Nationals), in World Curling Tour Events, and in the Men's Super League.
2. The next 4 Teams will then pre-qualify based on their placing in the 2015-2016 Men's Super League regular season. Please note that these teams must meet the minimum team retention criteria (2 returning players including the fourth-rock thrower, or 3 returning players not including the fourth-rock thrower). It should also be noted that these teams must have finished in the top 10 in the 2015-2016 Men's Super League regular season.
3. In the event that 12 or fewer teams apply they will all be admitted to the league, regardless of their points or their placing in the 2015-2016 Men's Super League. However, in the event that 13 or more teams apply only 7 Teams will pre-qualify based on the Cumulative Points System, with 4 Teams still getting in based on their placing in the 2015-2016 Men's Super League regular season. All remaining teams will then take part in a Pre-Season Double Knock-Out Play-Down, which will determine the final spot in the in the 2016-2017 Men's Super League.
