Event Information

Recreational Event

The OSWTT recreational event caters to 2.0-3.5 players. Half of the event is a 1-hour and 15 minute group clinic, with instruction and drills organized by Golden Bears and Pandas tennis team members and SCSC tennis coaches. The second half is a 1-hour and 15 minute modified 2-player team tennis event, with players playing both singles and doubles.

There are two distinct dates that players may sign up for, with each event capped at 16 players.

Players may sign up as a single entry or with a partner.

Intermediate/Competitive Event

The intermediate and competitive events follow the world team tennis rules, with teams of 6-8 players competing in men's singles and doubles, women's singles and doubles, and mixed doubles.

Teams are first placed into one of 2 pools of 4 to complete a round robin. Teams are then seeded and move to an elimination draw. This guarantees all teams a minimum of 4 fixtures.

All events include a Dri-Fit shirt & a meal voucher

Cost
