Event Information

Recreational Event

The OSWTT recreational event caters to 2.0-3.5 players. Half of the event is a 1-hour and 15 minute group clinic, with instruction and drills organized by Golden Bears and Pandas tennis team members and SCSC tennis coaches. The second half is a 1-hour and 15 minute modified 2-player team tennis event, with players playing both singles and doubles.

The recreational event will have a clinic taking place on Thursday (5:30pm-6:45pm) and match play will be Friday (7pm-8:30pm) and is capped at 16 players.

Players may sign up as a single entry or with a partner.

Cost is \$75 per player.

Each player must fill in the required information under the recreational category. Players will be placed on teams before the singles and doubles matches, if you have a partner you are automatically paired up.

Intermediate/Competitive Event

The intermediate and competitive events follow the world team tennis rules, with teams of 6-8 players competing in men's singles and doubles, women's singles and doubles, and mixed doubles.

Cost is \$100 per player.

Teams are first placed into one of 2 pools of 4 to complete a round robin. Teams will then cross over and play one playoff match. This guarantees all teams 4 fixtures.

Each player must fill in the required information under the Intermediate / Competitive category. Captains will be required to submit team rosters.
