

SPUD LEAGUE INCIDENT REPORT

(DO NOT USE AN INCIDENT REPORT FOR GAME RELATED MATTERS.)

Incident reports are used to report behavior witnessed by or reported to an official that occurs OFF THE ICE by non-participants of the game. Fans ejected for Zero Tolerance violations, fans fighting in the stands, officials confronted and/or verbally abused off the ice surface by anyone. Threats made to an Official leaving the building is an example of things reported on the Incident Report.

This report is to be used to inform the SPUD League of any incidents that occur at a game that involves spectators, rink personnel, players, coaches, minor officials, team officials, or any other people who are not covered in the Playing Rules. Such incidents might involve verbal or physical abuse of an official, an altercation between spectators, confrontations in the parking lot or anything else that is detrimental to the game of amateur hockey and displays poor sportsmanship. Please fill in the information requested below, and send this report to your SPUD Director. If you don't know the details, just relate what you saw.
