Atom female won their league, Atom C and Atom B lost out in first round of playoffs, Atom A lost in league semifinals, represented Zone 7 at provincials but lost out in the round robin.

Peewee female won their league, represented zone 7 at provincials and lost out in the semifinals. Peewee B team lost out in the first round of playoffs, Peewee A team lost out in the league finals, and did not try for provincials this year.

Bantam female lost out in the first round of the playoffs and lost out to Irma in the zone 7 play downs. Bantam male team lost out in the first round of league playoffs and did not try for provincials.

Midget female lost out in the league finals but then went on to win "B" provincials representing zone 7. Midget C team lost out in the first round of playoffs, Midget B team lost out in the second round of playoffs, Midget A team won their league and then went on to win "A" provincials that we hosted this year.

Due to a lack of teams within NCMHA for midget tier 1 we decided to move our midget A team to the CAHL league this year, which proved to be a positive and successful experience. Around January we learned that most of the associations around and west of Hiway 2 were thinking about moving their teams to

the CAHL, we at that time organized a meeting with those associations and learned that this was true mostly due to the fact that Red Deer moved to the CAHL this year and these associations were tired of driving thru Red Deer and not playing them when they were so close in proximity to these associations. We talked to NCMHA about this concern, they proceeded to talk to these associations and have now decided to try and inter league format between the 1660 and NEAHL leagues with the remaining associations. We intern have been accepted into the CAHL to take as many teams as we so choose, the team numbers have to be sent in to the leagues in September so the decision will be made at that time as to how many teams we decide to send.
