

Report from NEAHL AGM 2015

-Pee wee Tiering will be done again as it was in 2014 with each week's schedule out by Monday at the latest.

-Communication Protocol developed to be followed from now on

a) Ref write ups: game sheet to each manager, ref write up goes directly to league governors, league governor will work with Division Deputy and then Division Deputy will send suspension to team manager

b) Ref concerns: go to local association president, if valid president submits concern to league and Hockey Alberta Zone rep and if league, association or Alberta Zone rep feels has merit it will be forwarded to Ref Discipline Chairman for review by Ref Council, response back to league and Association

c) league issues: review concerns at AGM, must be in writing and only from president of association, league will put together a committee to review and get back to association president

-affiliations will remain at 12 max with no replacement of suspended players

-Bylaws are being revamped and will be update online in the fall

-2 ref 1 linesman trials was done in Provost at Midget level and it was positive so suggestion will be made to do the same at all Midget games

-League will be taking a stronger stance against fan bad behavior; more strikes will be handed out if Associations do not discipline their people

-No refusal to release to AA teams allowed, they are now considered elite

-Any input the Association wants to make into the updated League Bylaws forward to Randy by the end of April

-If team is playing in the league final series the manager need to ensure the banner is at the game, if no one from the league is able to attend someone from local association to present the banner to winning team

-boundaries were changed to include Boyle and Plamondon

-Wainwright is coming back to league with all teams next year

-Vegreville has been granted permission to put teams in league next year, unsure at this time which teams they will bring in, likely Midget 1 for sure.

Communication Protocol

1. Ref Write ups
 - a. Game Sheets go to respective Managers
 - b. Ref write ups go directly to League Governors
 - c. League Governors work with respective Division Deputy's
 - d. Division Deputy Governors – send suspension notice to Manager of respective team.
2. Ref concerns
 - a. Go to local association President
 - b. Submit concern if valid to league and Hockey Alberta Zone Rep
 - i. See NEZ Complaint Procedure (nezrc.ca)
 - c. If league, Local Minor Hockey Board, or Hockey Alberta Zone Rep feels merit to the concern they will forward letter to the Zone Discipline Chairman
 - d. Investigation into concern by Referee Council
 - e. Response back to League, Local Minor Hockey Board
3. League Issues
 - a. Review concerns or items at AGM's
 - b. All concerns or complaints must be in writing and from local Association Presidents
 - c. League will put together committee to review and present back to Association President

North East Zone Referee's Committee: NEZ Complaint Procedure



Procedure for filing a Complaint in Northeast Zone

Step One: Letter from team management to:

- (a) League,
- (b) Local Minor Hockey Board, or
- (c) Hockey Alberta Zone Rep.

Letter must include the following:

- 1. Date of game
- 2. Location of Game
- 3. Names of officials (obtained from the game sheet)
- 4. Nature of Concern
- 5. Name, Address (e-mail or home), and Phone Number of concerned person.

Step Two: if league, Local Minor Hockey Board, or Hockey Alberta Zone Rep. feels there is merit to the concern, they will forward the letter to either the Zone Discipline Chairman.

Step Three: Investigation into concern by Referee Council.

Step Four: Response to league, Local Minor Hockey Board, or Hockey Alberta Zone Rep. and team management. Once a letter of complaint has been received, the Northeast Zone Discipline Chair, will review the incident with the Discipline Committee. If the letter of complaint is deemed to have merit by the Discipline Committee, an investigation will be completed. Once the investigation is complete by the Discipline Committee, a response will be issued to the Team Manager outlining the findings and actions taken.
